The purpose of the educational program

Comprehensive and high-quality training of competitive specialists in the area of philology and humanities, language, interpersonal and intercultural communication.

Why is it worth choosing this program?

The uniqueness of the program lies in the combination of fundamental philological education in the area of literary studies, linguistics and translation studies. The best expertise from university programs in foreign philology in Russia and abroad (Great Britain, Germany) was used in its development. In the learning process, students study a wide range of subjects related to various areas of applied philology: computer and mathematical linguistics, corpus linguistics, experimental linguistics, etc

Description of the educational process

The basic part of these programs consists of such disciplines as foreign language, history, philosophy, introduction to communication theory, introduction to literary criticism, introduction to linguistics, the basics of philology.

Starting from the third year, variable disciplines appear depending on the profile of training:

applied and experimental phonetics,

linguistic resources of the Internet, discussion issues of Russian language morphology, sociolinguistics, philological analysis of the text, theory and practice of simultaneous translation, poetry of Great Britain, poetry of the USA, etc.

The educational process is carried out by the academic staff, who conduct active research activities in the area of the Russian language, foreign languages, Russian and foreign literature. Students are given the opportunity to study on exchange programs and undergo internships in leading universities in Germany, Spain, and the United States according to the relevant signed agreements.

The Institute of Philology and Intercultural Communication has a material and technical base that ensures the conduct of all disciplinary and interdisciplinary training, practical and research work of students, provided for by the curriculum in the training direction.

From the second year, it is compulsory for everyone to write research term papers, and in the fourth year - the final qualifying work.

Skills that students acquire after completing the educational program

A graduate who has finished the bachelor's program is ready to demonstrate an understanding of the history, current

state and prospects for the development of philology in general and its specific (profile) area, knowledge of the main provisions and concepts in the area of general linguistics, theory and history of the main studied language, communication theory;

possesses the skills of preparing scientific reviews, annotations, compiling abstracts and bibliographies on the topic of ongoing research, techniques of bibliographic description, skills of participating in scientific discussions, presentations and reports,

oral, written and virtual (placement in information networks) presentation of materials of their own research; is able to demonstrate possession of basic skills in finalizing and processing various types of texts, skills in translating various types of texts.

This program provides for purposeful work on the final qualifying work in the language, which, in particular, provides a comprehensive preparation for professional translation activities

Areas of professional activity where graduates have advantages

Graduates can successfully find employment as translators in educational, cultural and administrative institutions; employees in travel agencies, literary and literary-art museums; media editors and proofreaders; representatives in embassies and diplomatic missions. Graduates can work as teachers in schools and colleges, editors, proofreaders in publishing houses, the media, experts in the centers of linguistic expertise, perform the duties of a press secretary, assistant, administrator in government agencies and private companies, take part in the compilation of language guides.

Specializations within this programme

Applied Philology: Russian Language and Literature

This program is aimed at comprehensive training of bachelor degree students, combining the two main parts of philology – linguistics and literary criticism. Students enrolled in this program will have in-depth knowledge of modern directions of applied philology.

The goal of the bachelor's program is to build professional competencies including the ability to work with a variety of texts - written, oral and virtual (hypertexts and verbal elements of multimedia objects); knowledge of Russian and foreign languages, Russian and world literature, world arts; the ability to apply the knowledge and skills in their research, applied and project-oriented activities.

In the learning process, students develop the following professional competencies: the ability to apply the knowledge gained in the area of theory and history of the Russian language and literature, communication theory, philological analysis and interpretation of the text in their own research activities; the ability to conduct independent research in the field of philology

Foreign Philology: English Language and Literature, Translation Studies

This programme is offered in both full-time and extramural forms

This program is aimed at comprehensive training of bachelor degree students, combining the two main parts of philology – linguistics and literary criticism). Students enrolled in this program will have in-depth knowledge about the structure and interrelationships of both the linguistic and literary processes.

The uniqueness of the program is in the combination of fundamental philological education in the field of literary criticism and in linguistics. When developed the curriculum of the program preserved the qualities that make up the strong side of university programs in foreign philology in Russia have been preserved, the qualities that are actively used in similar European and American programs as well.

Students specialize either in English language and literature or in Spanish language and literature. The second foreign language (German, French, Spanish or English), as well as translation studies disciplines, is an obligatory part of the program.

Applied Philology: Tatar Language and Literature, Journalism

This program is aimed at comprehensive training of bachelor degree students who have in-depth knowledge of Tatar Philology. Students study history and current state of the Tatar language, literature and journalism.

Graduates work in educational institutions, editorial offices of newspapers and magazines, book publishers and public services. The program Applied Philology: Tatar Language and Literature, Journalism focus on the acquisition of skills for professional level work with various types of texts (creation, editing, translation, examination of official, business, journalistic and other types of texts) and the implementation of linguistic, interpersonal and interethnic written and oral communication.

Students applying for this program must demonstrate the knowledge of the Tatar language at an advanced level (B2 on CEFR).

Applied Philology: Russian as a Foreign Language with in-depth study of Foreign Languages

This program prepares specialists who have fundamental knowledge in the field of philology. The curriculum includes General Linguistics and Theory of Literature, the History of Russian and World Literature, Theory and Practice of Teaching Russian as a Foreign Language, Information Technologies in Education and Philology. The students master several foreign languages (Russian as a foreign language, English/Chinese, etc. (choice of a student) and develop skills for effective international cooperation.

The applicants must pass exams in Russian, a foreign language and Social Studies (in the Unified State Exam format). For international applicants, the level of Russian proficiency should not lower than the First Certification level (B1 on CEFR).

Foreign Philology: Spanish Language and Literature, translation Studies

The uniqueness of the programs lies in the combination of fundamental philological education in the area of literary criticism, linguistics and translation studies. During its development, the qualities that combine the strong side of university programs in foreign philology in Russia and abroad (Great Britain, Germany, Spain) were preserved. These programs are aimed at developing the ability to communicate in oral and written forms in a foreign language in its literary form, as well as the ability to translate various types of texts (mainly scientific and journalistic); annotation and abstracting of documents, scientific works and works of art in foreign languages.
