This course is aimed students with prior knowledge of the Russian language, who are planning to continue learning Russian and further develop their skills. To enroll in this course, students should have already studied Russian and acquired a B1 or B2 level according to CEFR or should demonstrate their proficiency to the admissions team.

Successful completion of this course enables the student to carry out professional activities in the Russian language as a linguist, translator, editor, journalist, diplomat, manager, working in a Russian-speaking staff. By the end of the course, students will be able to read fluently various texts in sociocultural and official spheres, write their own versions of texts they have heard or read, understand everyday life conversations (announcements, news, TV features, etc.), participate in a conversation, initiate a dialogue asking questions on the topic of the conversation, describe something they have seen, express their opinion.

During the programme students take 20 hours of classes each week. Students will be assessed at the start of the course and organised into classes according to their level of Russian. All classes will be organized in groups.

At the end of the course, all students are invited to be examined for the Russian government's certificate III level of the Russian language qualification TORFL (C1), which is the Russian Language equivalent of IELTS in comparison to the English Language system.
