The aim

The programme is suitable for students from a variety of backgrounds, including those with industry experience and those have not studied economics, finance or accountancy at bachelors level. The objective of the programme

You develop your knowledge, understanding and insight into how banks, financial institutions and markets function in the economy and global financial system. You also develop an appropriate range of cognitive, critical, intellectual and research skills, plus relevant personal and interpersonal skills to interact in the real world of business and finance. The programme will be of particular interest to those wishing to build careers within banks, specialised financial institutions and fund management, securities dealing firms, multinational companies, or to occupy roles in corporate financial management and independent financial advice.

- develop your ability to apply quantitative techniques to finance and banking practice;
- develop an appropriate range of cognitive, critical and intellectual skills, research skills and relevant personal and interpersonal skills;
- provide you with the knowledge of the financial regulations that exist within the financial world;
- provide preparation for and/or development of a career in financial services/banking by developing your skills at a professional or equivalent level, or as preparation for research or further study in the area;
- add value to your first degree by developing your integrated and critical awareness and understanding in the field of financial services;
- develop your ability to conduct independent self-directed research.

Upon successful completion of this programme, you should be able to:

• acquire an advanced level of knowledge of the theories, models and practice of banking, finance, investment, risk, and regulation;

- understand how the role of banking and finance integrates within the wider business environment;
- demonstrate clarity in problem definition, and demonstrate the ability to critically analyse and use relevant information to offer interpretations and solutions within a multi-disciplinary banking business perspective;
- recognise and respond to the relationships between different functions within financial services organisations.
