## Core skills

Linguistics will give you specific expertise in your areas of interest, but will also provide you with many more general, transferable skills. Common skills gained from linguistics bachelor include:

- Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary skills
- Analytical skills, and the ability to turn raw data into hard findings
- Team-working skills
- Critical and lateral thinking
- Understanding of the subject-specific lexicon
- Problem-solving skills
- A wide and in-depth understanding of language which can be applied to other areas
- A framework for keeping pace with developments in a constantly evolving field
- Self-management skills
- Time management and organization skills
- Excellent communication skills, and the ability to present information to both laymen and experts
- Interpretation and translation skills

The educational activities include classroom teaching, workshops and internships, in order to acquire wide-ranging skills that can be readily transferable into the world of work. Knowledge acquired by students will be assessed through written and oral exams during the entire university career.
