This programme is carried out on a full-time basis (5 years). Students may choose one of two specialisations:

The programs of both specialisations are designed to deliver both general knowledge and specific training in the chosen specialisation.

An advantageous difference between a specialist's and a bachelor's degree is that the former is a 5-year education

familiar to Russian employers, at the end of which a graduate receives the title of specialist (lawyer). The main advantage of the programme is its high prestige in the eyes of employers and full training. Specialists have the opportunity to teach at Russian universities and the right to hold positions in government. In addition, it is convenient for those who plan to engage in scientific work and further study at graduate school - a specialist can immediately enter graduate school, bypassing the master's programme.
